Inductees are selected from nominees and announced prior to the induction, which is presented at the Gala Finale.

Proman joins us this year to sponsor the **Green Agenda Award** category. With the growing importance of sustainability in a world threatened by environmental challenges, this award recognizes that corporate T&T has a part to play in doing what is right for the environment, our planet and future generations.
