Our recent high-level engagements with the World Bank Group and IDB Invest reflect this shift. These synergies aim to reposition government as a facilitator and regulator, energising private sector-led growth, and expanding non-energy revenues to achieve long-term fiscal resilience.

We are targeting between US\$2 billion and US\$5 billion in private sector funding over the next three to five years to support this bold diversification agenda. We intend you, our private sector, to be the drivers of this growth for the benefit of all of Trinidad and Tobago.

We are also exploring innovative financing models, such as those supported by the International Finance Corporation (IFC) and Multilateral Investment Guarantee Agency (MIGA), which can de-risk investment for private actors, thereby catalysing growth in agriculture, housing, transportation, water and energy infrastructure, and more.

Environmental Stewardship: Sustainability as Strategy

No competitive future is possible without climate resilience. Through our Environmental Policy Planning Division and Green Fund Executing Unit, we are leading the national response to climate change.

We are developing the National Framework for Sustainable Development to preserve biodiversity, promote renewable energy, and support sustainable communities.

Statistics and Data: Evidence-Based Planning

Strategic vision must be based on facts and data, not guesswork. Our Central Statistical Office (CSO) ensures that every decision we make is backed by reliable, timely and comprehensive data. From economic forecasting to population trends, our national planning is guided by data through the National Transformation Unit and cutting-edge policy instruments.

Spatial and Urban Planning: Building Liveable Spaces

We envision vibrant, connected communities where infrastructure meets the needs of citizens. Through the Town and Country Planning Division and allied agencies, we are actively shaping land use policy, urban development and rural revitalisation in a way that supports health, safety, and economic opportunity.

The DevelopTT electronic construction permitting system has enabled faster and more transparent approvals, helping businesses get off the ground quickly.

Global Partnerships: Local Action, Global Standards

Our outreach to global institutions such as the World Bank, IDB, CDB and the EU ensures that we stay aligned with international best practice while securing funding, technical assistance and investment for national priorities. These relationships are instrumental in advancing Trinidad and Tobago's competitive position in the global economy.

A Connected, Competitive Tomorrow

As we look ahead, I want to assure the members of the Trinidad and Tobago Chamber of Industry and Commerce that this Government is committed to supporting a thriving, resilient private sector.

Sector by Sector: Global Prospects

Energy Services

The global energy sector is undergoing a significant transition, with increasing demand for energy, a focus on renewable energy investments, and a shift away from fossil fuels. While demand for all energy sources—including oil, natural gas, and coal—is still rising, low-carbon sources are growing rapidly and are projected to account for a substantial portion of global power generation by 2050.

According to Fortune Business Insights¹, the global energy as a service (EaaS) market size was valued at US\$77.56 million in 2023 and was projected to grow from US\$85.62 million in 2024 to US\$208.20 million by 2032, at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 11.75%. North America dominated the EaaS market with a market share of 43.85% in 2023.

In the Trinidad and Tobago context, in 2022, the energy sector contributed approximately 36% of GDP, 81% of total exports and 55% of fiscal revenues.

Distribution Services

Global distribution services are experiencing significant growth and transformation. The global logistics market generated revenue of US\$3,931.8 billion in 2024. This is expected to climb to US\$5,951 billion by 2030, growing at a 7.2% CAGR.

Key trends include the rise of e-commerce, sustainability initiatives, and technological advancements like blockchain and Artificial Intelligence (AI), which are reshaping how goods are distributed worldwide. The Asia-Pacific region was the largest revenue generating market in 2024².

The distribution sector, also referred to as Trade and Repairs, is a vital part of the Trinidad and Tobago economy. It comprises wholesale and retail trade, logistics, and the distribution of goods like natural gas and petroleum. In 2023, after the energy sector, it was the largest economic sector in Trinidad and Tobago, at 25.3% of GDP.

ICT Services

The Information and Communication Technology (ICT) sector is ranked as one of the largest industries in the world.

Moreover, the global ICT sector is poised for continued growth, with analysts projecting significant expansion in various segments such as IT spending, AI, and data centers. While traditional tech spending will continue, emerging technologies such as big data, analytics, social, mobile, and next-generation security solutions are expected to drive much of this growth.

The ICT market is projected to reach US\$6.03 trillion in 2025, with a forecast of US\$7.86 trillion by 2030, growing at a CAGR of 5.45% (2025-2030).

In 2023, the ICT sector accounted for roughly 2.34% of Trinidad and Tobago's GDP.

Sector by Sector: Global Prospects

Banking, Financial Services and Insurance

The banking, financial services and insurance (BFSI) activities sector comprises monetary intermediation—including commercial banking activities, credit unions and central banking activities—along with insurance, pension funding activities and activities to support financial services.

According to Fortune Business Insights⁴, the global property and casualty insurance market size was valued at US\$1,577.88 billion in 2024. This market is expected to grow from US\$1,920.56 billion in 2025 to US\$2,571.41 billion by 2032, with a CAGR of 4.3%.

Factors driving this growth are government regulations, frequent climate changes, technological innovations and increasing consumer awareness.

Other subsectors under BFSI include:

- The global **personal loans market**. This was valued at US\$387.37 billion in 2024. The market is projected to grow from US\$429.78 billion in 2025 to US\$1,094.77 billion by 2032, with a CAGR of 14.3%⁵.
- **Mobile payments**. These offer a secure and convenient alternative to cash, allowing customers to transfer money instantly. The growing availability of high-speed mobile

networks and the widespread use of smartphones are driving the adoption of mobile payment solutions. This subsector was valued at US\$3.84 trillion in 2024. It is projected to grow from US\$4.97 trillion in 2025 to US\$26.53 trillion by 2032, demonstrating a CAGR of 27%. In 2024, the Asia-Pacific region led the global market for mobile payments, accounting for 45.31% of the total share⁶.

- The global fintech market was valued at US\$340.10 billion in 2024. It is expected to grow to US\$394.88 billion in 2025, reaching US\$1,126.64 billion by 2032. This reflects a CAGR of 16.2%. In 2024, North America held the largest market share of the global fintech market, accounting for 34.05% of the global total⁷. Trinidad and Tobago's BFSI sector continues to grow, accounting for 7.46% of GDP in 2023.

Business and Professional Services

The global business and professional services industry is undergoing robust growth, with the market expected to reach a value of US\$7.77 trillion by 2025. This expansion is driven by digital transformation, shifting client expectations and rising demand for specialized expertise across multiple sectors.

While developed economies continue to be key markets, developing countries are increasingly contributing to growth through sectoral investments and economic development initiatives.

Professional services accounted for 2.25% of GDP for Trinidad and Tobago in 2023.

Tourism

In 2024, tourism accounted for 10% of the global economy, contributing US\$10.9 trillion to global GDP, and supporting some 357 million jobs worldwide. International visitor spending also surged in 2024, reaching US\$1.9 trillion⁸.

According to the World Travel and Tourism Council (WTTC)⁹, the Travel & Tourism sector is projected to contribute \$16.5 trillion to the global economy by 2035, representing 11.5% of global GDP. This reflects a decade-long annual growth rate of 3.5%, outpacing the broader economy's projected growth rate of 2.5%.

Food and Beverages

The global food and beverages industry is expected to grow from US\$1,687.61 billion in 2023 to US\$2,200.0 billion by 2032, with a CAGR of approximately 2.99% during the forecast period of 2024-2032¹⁰.

Sector by Sector: Global Prospects

In Trinidad and Tobago, firms in the food and beverage sector represent a good source of foreign exchange, particularly those engaged in exports. In 2023, the accommodation and food service sector represented 1.56% of the country's GDP, while food and beverage manufacturing generated 4.61% of GDP.

Agriculture

According to the World Bank Group, agriculture has the potential to reduce poverty, increase incomes, and enhance food security for the 80% of the world's poor who live in rural areas, and who primarily depend on farming for their livelihoods.

- Gross production value (GPV) in the global agriculture market is projected to amount to US\$4.82 trillion in 2025. An annual CAGR of 3.44% is expected for 2025-2029, resulting in a GPV of US\$5.52 trillion in 2029. The import value of the global agriculture market is projected to amount to US\$939.5 billion in 2025, with an annual CAGR of 3.31% between 2025-2029.

- The global agriculture market's export value is projected to amount to US\$865.2 billion in 2025, with an expected CAGR of 3.56% during 2025–2029¹¹.

In 2023, Trinidad and Tobago's agricultural sector contributed some 0.82% to the country's over-all GDP.

Navigating Growth in Trinidad and Tobago: Key Economic Signals for 2025 and Beyond

Trinidad and Tobago (T&T), our beautiful twin-island Caribbean nation of Trinidad and Tobago (T&T) is home to approximately 1.368 million people.

From an economic perspective, the country has traditionally relied on the petrochemical sector, which has seen a decline in production leading to a reduced contribution to the overall economy.

From a global perspective, the midpoint of 2025 finds the global economy navigating a volatile mix of macroeconomic headwinds and structural shifts. Momentum has remained generally stable, but growth trajectories are diverging sharply across geographies and sectors. With T&T generally operating with deficit budgets over the past several years, as well as declining foreign exchange reserves, the Government has been tasked with the responsibility of diversifying the economy.

In June 2025 in his inaugural mid-year Budget review, the new Minister of Finance, The Honorable Davendranath Tancoo MP, announced a

projected fiscal deficit of \$9.67 billion for the year 2025.

While certain measures were mentioned during his mid-year Budget speech for improving the economy—including the introduction of transfer pricing legislation, business levy reform, as well as the introduction of an export allowance—it is left to be seen which measures would be implemented when the full budget presentation is made (possibly in October 2025).

In this regard, this article explores key considerations that impact the performance of the T&T economy.

It also highlights areas of focus for the Government of T&T aimed at engendering a healthy and secure business environment.

Current State of the Energy Sector

Despite a decline in the production of oil and gas, the petrochemical sector remains vital to T&T's economy. It is encouraging, therefore, to see upstream oil and gas operators such as Perenco

announce significant columns of natural gas in two separate geological compartments on the eastern part of the Onyx field.

Further, the announcement by bp Trinidad and Tobago—T&T's largest gas producer—that it achieved two major milestones sanctioning the Ginger gas development and exploration success at its Frangipani well, signal encouraging prospects for T&T.

Looking ahead, this country also recently signed an Agreement with the Government of Grenada to enhance energy collaboration and has entered into a production-sharing contract with Exxon Mobil expected to lead to an investment by that company of US\$42.5 million in the first phase of the project.

Apart from the positive upstream success stories mentioned above, T&T's Point Lisas Industrial Estate continues to benefit from several international companies operating therein. In fact, **T&T has been recently reputed as the largest exporter of ammonia in the**

world, with the majority of its exports going to United States of America (USA), followed by the European Union (EU) and United Kingdom (UK).

In addition, T&T established its first Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) facility (Train 1) in the year 1999, which was followed by subsequent LNG facilities (Trains 2, 3 and 4) in the years 2002, 2003 and 2005, respectively. While a limited gas supply has resulted in the closure of Train 1, there has been a restructuring of the Atlantic LNG companies that own and operate the aforementioned Trains, which is intended to bring about greater efficiency moving forward.

Despite these laudable accomplishments, the T&T economy has not been immune to the effects of geopolitical factors and external market shocks, which have been characterized by fluctuating oil and gas prices, thereby impacting on the country's revenue generating capacity.

For example, conflicts in the Middle East have had the effect of inflating oil and gas prices. In addition, the recent announcement and moves by the U.S. Government to deploy military vessels on the border of Venezuela could potentially lead to the disruption oil and gas supply chains.

The volatility of these conflict situations, coupled with other recent developments such as the introduction of new taxes on petro

chemical imports in Europe, reinforce the need to focus on diversification and explore other bilateral trading arrangements.

Indeed, **the CARICOM Private Sector Organisation (CPSO) estimates that T&T stands to lose an estimated US\$291.9 million in potential export revenue because of the increase in tariffs from 10% to 15% on T&T's exports to the U.S.**

While the tariffs do not apply to oil and gas, two major sectors impacted by the tariff increase are the base metals and articles thereof (including iron and steel products) and chemicals (including products such as anhydrous ammonia, methanol and urea). In another development of great concern, **Micro and Small to Medium Sized Entities (MSMEs) who use the Trinidad and Tobago Postal Corporation (TTPost) to export packages to the U.S. have halted this practice due to a recent U.S. Executive Order, "Suspending Duty-Free De Minimis Treatment for all Countries". This can lead to these MSMEs suffering quite significant losses.**

Diversification of the T&T Economy

The word "*diversification*" is more than just a buzz word—it is a key item on the agenda of the Government of T&T.

Admittedly, there has been a gradual shift away from the traditional reliance on the petrochemical sector and increased focus on other sectors which have been contributing positively to the T&T economy including, inter alia:

1. Manufacturing and Distribution
2. MSMEs
3. Creative Industries
4. Renewable energy/ sustainability
5. Agriculture.

Key achievements in these sectors include:

- Agostini Limited acquiring an 80% stake in Chinook Trading Canada Limited.
- ANSA McAL's acquisition of US-based chlor-alkali producer BleachTech LLC, its largest acquisition in ANSA McAL's 143-year history.
- Massy Holdings' purchase of Rowe's IGA Supermarkets, an independent supermarket chain with seven stores in Florida.
- Medcorp Limited, being the fourth company to become listed on the SME listing on the T&T stock exchange.
- From a cultural perspective, our very own Mr. Joshua Regrello entering the Guinness Book of Records for our national instrument, the steelpan. Moreover, we have seen the son of our very own Mr. Liam Teague, namely Jaden Teague-Nunez, taking steelpan to a next level internationally.

- BP Alternative Energy Trinidad and Tobago (bpATT) and Shell Renewables Caribbean (Shell) are developing a 112MWac/148MWp solar project in collaboration with Lightsource bp. This project, which includes the Brechin Castle Solar Farm, is a significant step in T&T's renewable energy strategy.
- From an agriculture perspective, Berrycove Ltd, a joint venture between Anthony N Sabga Ltd, Island Growers Caribbean and Alquimi Renewables LLC was established to produce tens of thousands of pounds of assorted berries and organic greens annually. The project focused on growing temperate crops in an advanced greenhouse farm at the Cove Industrial Estate, Tobago.

There are many other notable accomplishments however, we are unable to list all in this article. Moreover, while these accomplishments are commendable, it is imperative that the T&T Government continues to foster an environment that promotes diversification and the growth of MSMEs.

With this in mind, the proclamation of the Trinidad and Tobago Special Economic Zones Act (TTSEZA) may be used as a catalyst to attract foreign direct investment (FDI) and advance the diversification thrust. Attached in Appendix 1 is a Newsletter which summarizes the benefits to be derived from the TTSEZA.

Challenges Ahead

Despite the optimism that may be derived from the positive initiatives outlined above, T&T faces several challenges, including:

1. Access to foreign exchange – it has become cliché that access to foreign currency has been extremely challenging particularly stymieing business operations and profitability. To unleash the full potential of our MSME market, this situation should be addressed.
2. High crime rates continue to garner negative attention regionally and globally given its devastating impact of disrupting the safety and well-being of persons and businesses which may act as a deterrent to attracting FDI.
3. T&T still ranks relatively low on the ease of doing business index, partly due to bureaucratic hurdles and underutilized technology.
4. T&T continues to be blacklisted by the EU which has impacted trading opportunities and resulted in the repealing of certain Double Taxation Treaties, namely the Denmark/T&T and the Norway/T&T Treaties. We note however, that the Honorable Minister of Finance recently noted that T&T is on track for delisting in February 2026. New tariffs and taxes from developed nations could reduce the competitiveness of goods manufactured and exported from T&T.
5. The high 30% withholding tax rate applicable under the United States/T&T Double Taxation Treaty may discourage T&T nationals seeking to invest and/or conduct business in the US. A revision to the terms of the aforementioned Treaty is therefore recommended.

Conclusion

In summary, whilst there are challenges that lie ahead, T&T is well positioned to rise and overcome them. There are notable opportunities for collaboration in the petrochemical sector, especially with CARICOM neighbors. The Government of T&T is also evaluating the possibility of restarting the Pointe-A-Pierre refinery, which could further enhance regional partnerships. Sustainable economic growth will depend on diversification, innovation, and investment in human capital. By enhancing opportunities in these areas, T&T can build a resilient economy that benefits all citizens.

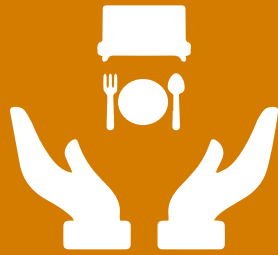

Export Excellence and Private Sector Growth in the Caribbean

In an era of rapid global transformation and increasing geopolitical tensions, Caribbean enterprises must continue to strategically pursue trading opportunities: broadening their horizons while deepening their overall contribution to sustainable growth and prosperity.

Private sector participation represents the lifeblood of Caribbean economies and as such, export excellence is not solely about increasing sales beyond our borders, but it represents a deeper commitment to the development of our Region, its identity, and its people.

For small open economies, export excellence amplifies their devotion to continuous improvement undergirded by a strong, innovative, and inclusive private sector capable of adapting, competing, and succeeding in the global marketplace.

Exports are vital to the Caribbean's economic development. They generate foreign exchange and create jobs. They also facilitate knowledge transfer and contribute to macroeconomic stability.

For small island states, which often face the challenges of limited resources and a high dependency on imports¹, success in export markets helps to balance the development equation and remains key to achieving long-term growth.

In recent years, the region has taken a multi-faceted approach, not only towards improving the quality and quantity of its exports, but also towards enhancing competitiveness and the terms under which it trades.

There has been a growing emphasis on strengthening export capacity and competitiveness across the Caribbean through the development of special economic and trade zones and targeted sector

development programmes, bolstered by aggressive national export strategies.

From a geopolitical standpoint, regional collaboration—through frameworks like the CARIFORUM-EU Economic Partnership Agreement² and various Cooperation Agreements at the CARICOM level—has proven particularly impactful in shaping a cohesive export and investment agenda.

Caribbean Export plays a central role in preparing the Caribbean private sector to boldly advance and seize the opportunities presented within these mechanisms.

Our support includes access to technical assistance, trade missions, digital marketing tools, and grant funding through initiatives like the Direct Assistance Grant Scheme (DAGS).

Export Excellence and Private Sector Growth in the Caribbean

To date, over 500 firms across various sectors have received support through DAGS, strengthening their export readiness, helping them meet international standards, and enabling them to enter new markets through innovation and strategic partnerships.

We, at Caribbean Export, remain committed to empowering regional businesses to pursue export excellence through targeted support that enhances competitiveness, fosters innovation, and encourages deeper collaboration across sectors and borders. However, the pursuit of our mandate to support export excellence is not without its challenges.

Private Sector Growth and Economic Diversification

The continued diversification of the Caribbean's export base remains essential for strengthening economic resilience, but the pace has been slow.

While tourism, agriculture, and commodity trade continue to anchor many economies, high-value and emerging industries such as niche market agro-processing, green and digital technologies, and business process outsourcing (BPO) require greater support to boost the region's global contribution within these high demand opportunities.

Nonetheless, there has been encouraging progress.

Trinidad and Tobago manufacturers of specialty food products, cosmetics and packaging materials are entering new markets within Latin America and West Africa.

Barbados is carving out a global presence in the life sciences industry while also pursuing premium export categories such as craft rum, gourmet sauces, and functional foods, which are featured at international trade shows and in retail chains.

Jamaica's BPO sector continues to evolve into a digital services hub, offering services such as data analytics, tech support, and fintech operations.

Across the board, we are witnessing Caribbean digital entrepreneurs enter the ever-evolving global market for technology services and products.

This progress is exemplified by firms such as Bitt Inc. (Barbados), a fintech trailblazer that developed the digital currency infrastructure for the Eastern Caribbean Central Bank; WiPay (Trinidad and Tobago), a digital payments platform expanding across the Caribbean and into Africa; EduFocal (Jamaica), which has

revolutionised online learning for students through gamification; and Caribshopper (Jamaica), an e-commerce platform connecting regional artisans with consumers in North America. **Additionally, regional platforms like Tech-Beach Retreat are creating vital linkages between Caribbean startups and global tech investors, helping to unlock new funding and scaling opportunities.**

Not only have these digital pursuits enhanced the Caribbean's global footprint; they also have enabled greater access to modern digital services within the region. These successes underscore the importance of forging partnerships beyond traditional markets and showcase the ability of the Caribbean private sector to operate and contribute meaningfully to the global economy

Supporting MSMEs: The Backbone of Caribbean Economies

Chief among the many challenges our private sector faces remain that of access to adequately priced and accessible financing. As such, the unlocking of largely untapped capital resources⁴ for the deployment of the private sector to pursue productive opportunities is still a priority to be realised.

Export Excellence and Private Sector Growth in the Caribbean

Without doubt, the role of the Caribbean private sector cannot be understated, accounting for at least 70% of employment, with small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) contributing approximately 40% to the region's GDP³. Unfortunately, only about 13% are actively engaged in exporting⁴. We urgently need to widen this base, if we are to maintain a competitive space in global markets and ensure the consistent supply of regional goods and services that the world is demanding.

Harnessing Digital Innovation

As the global economy becomes increasingly digital, the Caribbean also must ensure its private sector is equipped to thrive in this changing landscape. This is why Caribbean Export has formally established digital transformation as a strategic priority. We have been streamlining digital transformation support throughout our programmes.

For example, our Caribbean Digital Transformation Institute (CD-TI)—built with the support of the Inter-American Development Bank—provides support to firms that are seeking to advance their digital transformation processes. For the first time in our region, this initiative presents an opportunity to obtain a quantitative measure to track the progress of a firm's digital maturity, allowing firms to fast-track the integration of digital tools and enhancing their productivity⁵.

Global Markets, Local Champions: T&T Businesses on the World Stage

At chocolate festivals in Amsterdam, **Trinbagonian fine-flavour cocoa is making a name for itself not just for its quality, but for how its producers' techniques, honed over generations, are helping build resilience to climate change.**

From Saint Lucia to Spain, women entrepreneurs from Trinidad and Tobago have been participating in trade missions and fairs to showcase their products to new markets and build relationships with new buyers and partners.

And in Burkina Faso, the green tech company ProtofabTT's Solar-Ponix award-winning garden tower has now inspired a pilot programme to help support sustainable farming and food security.

These stories are just a few examples of the breadth and depth of what Trinbagonian businesses have to offer, from more traditional sectors like agriculture to newer ones like renewable energy.

Many are already making inroads into global markets, supporting not just better incomes in Trinidad and Tobago, but creating opportunities to share innovative technologies and time-honoured traditions alike with new audiences and partners.

As part of these efforts, ITC is also working with partners to build alliances that support sustainable value chains from agribusiness to the IT and BPO sectors, promoting income diversification, value addition, and improved market access.

At the same time, Trinidad and Tobago has built a strong and growing track record in making trade more connected, inclusive, and sustainable.

For instance, Trinidad and Tobago is already home to one of the world's SheTrades Hubs serving women entrepreneurs, hosted by the Ministry of Trade and Global Trinidad and Tobago.

We at ITC are proud to be a part of it. The stories of this SheTrades Hub, and of the women entrepreneurs it supports, have been shared at the highest levels of global trade policy-making, including at joint WTO-ITC events on women and trade, held alongside the WTO's latest ministerial conference in the United Arab Emirates.

These examples all speak to the potential of this country's private sector to drive its socio-economic development for the years to come, and to thrive on the world stage. But the work is not over yet.

One year since the international community came together for the Fourth International Conference on Small Island Developing States, **the urgency of putting the private sector in the driver's seat to ensure resilient prosperity has only grown more apparent.**

Global Markets, Local Champions: T&T Businesses on the World Stage

Hurricane seasons, shifting weather patterns, and the growing casualties exacted by a changing climate have made clear that now is the time to intensify efforts to support a blue-green economy that creates decent jobs, good incomes, and ensures climate resilience and food security. More recent disruptions to supply chains, including those caused by tariff escalations and geopolitical tensions, have reinforced that efforts to increase value addition, build SME competitiveness, and access new markets cannot wait.

Over eight in ten of Trinidad and Tobago's registered businesses are small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs), and they are increasingly active not just in the agricultural sector, but in energy, services, and manufacturing.

"When it comes to diversifying its exports and creating more value-added jobs, Trinidad and Tobago is already well on its way. But challenges persist—whether in making sure exporters have access to data on the latest market trends and intelligence, or in ensuring that they have the necessary finance to grow and trade.

These issues are particularly acute in the fast-growing sector of services.

That is why the National Trade Strategy 2025-2030 that Trinidad and Tobago is expanding is so critical. **It sets out—following extensive consultations—a set of strategic objectives that look at the whole picture of what SME competitiveness entails: from a supportive business ecosystem to diversified export sectors to building the presence of Trinbagonian exports on the international stage.**

It is a valuable complement to the trade policy framework that Trinidad and Tobago already has in place and articulates clearly the link between private sector development and trade policy, recognising that resilient prosperity is only possible when these are addressed together. The strategy is backed by a solid implementation governance approach, which will sustain the coordination between public and private sector that was set in motion during the strategy's design, bringing the private sector into an active steering role for the next five years and ensuring continuity.

Many of these lessons and experiences reflect the hopes, aspirations, and challenges that SMEs around the world face. **These were top-of-mind in July 2025 at the first-ever Global SME Ministerial, which took place in Johannesburg, South Africa. There, ministers exchanged ideas and best practices on how they can support small businesses in their respective countries, to help them navigate new frontiers—whether in undertaking the green transition, shaping the digital revolution, or accessing finance.**

Catalyst: Stories of Bold Moves, Bright Ideas, and Business Resilience

In today's business climate, success belongs to those willing to embrace change, think differently, and push beyond their comfort zones. That was the heartbeat of Catalyst - Propelling SMEs for Success in 2025, a two-day conference held on February 11th and 12th at the Leon Agostini Conference Hall.

The event set out to spark innovation and transformation within Trinidad and Tobago's small and medium enterprises (SMEs) not through abstract theory, but through lived experiences, practical strategies, and authentic dialogue. It was about bold moves, bright ideas, and the resilience that defines entrepreneurship in our region.
